

A new paragraph shall be added to the Constitutional Declaration that shall read as follows:

SECTION I

Without prejudice to the provisions of this Declaration, some persons shall be prohibited from assuming key positions, senior functions and high managerial posts in the state for a temporary period, by virtue of a law to be enacted in this regard, without prejudice to the principles of human right to litigation.”

SECTION II

Voting on Political Isolation Law shall be made by a majority of one hundred and one votes.

SECTION III

The provision of paragraph three of Article 30 of the Interim Constitutional Declaration shall be amended to read as follows:

1. Following at least 90 days from the first General National Congress session, the GNC shall appoint a Prime Minister who shall propose the names of the cabinet. The GNC shall appoint heads of key positions.
2. The GNC shall re-establish the High National Elections Commission ¹for the election of a constituent body through free and direct polling, from outside its members, to draft a permanent constitution of Libya, to be called the Constituent Body for Drafting the Constitution that shall comprise 60 members, in a manner similar to the 60-member committee that was formed to draft the Constitution of Libya in 1951.

The GNC shall be responsible for determining the regulations and criteria for its election, taking into consideration the representation of all components of the Libyan community with unique linguistic and cultural character.

3. Decisions of the constitution drafting constituent body shall be delivered through a majority of two-thirds of the votes plus one, provided the draft law is completed and approved within at least 120 days from the date of its first session.
