

- The General National Council (GNC) shall do the following within a period not exceeding thirty days from its first meeting:

1. Appoint a Prime Minister, who in turn shall nominate the members of his cabinet, provided that all of them receive the confidence of the GNC prior to undertaking their duties as a provisional government. The GNC shall appoint the heads of sovereign posts as well.

2. Selection of a statutory body from among non [GNC] members, which shall develop a draft constitution for the country. It shall be named "The Statutory Authority for the Constitution Drafting," and shall comprise of sixty members, similar to the Committee of Sixty established for the preparation of the Libyan Independence Constitution in 1951. In all cases, the decisions of the Statutory Authority shall be issued by a majority of two thirds plus one; it shall finalize the formulation the draft constitution and the adoption of this draft within a period not exceeding one hundred and twenty days from the convening of its first meeting.

- The Draft Constitution shall be presented for a "Yes" or "No" referendum within thirty days of its adoption; if the Libyan people approve the Constitution with a two thirds majority of the voters, the Statutory Authority shall endorse it as the Constitution of the Country and [it] shall be referred to the GNC for issuance. If it is not approved, the Statutory Authority shall re-draft it and present it for another referendum within a period not exceeding thirty days from the date of the announcement of the first referendum results.
- The GNC shall issue a Law on the General Elections in accordance with the Constitution within thirty days.
- The General Elections shall be held within one hundred and eighty days from the date of the issuance of the laws organizing that [the elections]. The GNC and the Provisional Government shall supervise the preparation of all that is required for a democratic and transparent conduct of the electoral process.
- The National High Electoral Commission (NHEC) (which shall be reformulated by the GNC) shall undertake the conduct of general elections under the supervision of the national judiciary and observation of the United Nations as well as international and regional organizations.
- The NHEC shall endorse and announce the results; the legislative authority shall be called to convene within a period not exceeding thirty days from the date of its endorsement by the GNC. During its [legislative authority's] first session the GNC shall be dissolved, and the legislative authority shall undertake its duties.
